


# Zipper slider and pull tab replacement, maintenance instructions



### Zipper tab replacement

If the hook on the zipper slider is intact, simply slip onto the hook, with a pair of pliers gently clamp closed. Use large pliers so you do not break the ring lock while squeezing the hook.



## Zipper slider head replacement (or broken ring or hook)

If you are handy with stitching, you will need to unstitch and pull out the end of the zipper track. Then slide on the new zipper head, tuck back in the zipper track and stitch back together.

Recommended a professional luggage repair shop should help you replace the zipper head if stitching is difficult for you.


## Zippers are hard to pull / stiff

Simply rub a small amount of candle wax (not hot) or bar of soap along the zipper tracks and pull the zipper sliders back and forth a few times. This will help make pulling the zippers more smoothly.

## Zipper track / teeth are not closing together

Our zipper tracks are self repairable. Simply pull the zippers back and forth a couple of times, if stiff / hard to pull, see above.

Or with a pair of small pliers, gently pinch the edges of the zipper head which should help lock the zipper teeth together. See image illustration below where to pinch the zipper head.



If any zipper teeth on the zipper track is broken or missing, they cannot be repaired.
